American Rescue Allocation Plan

The Will County Regional Office of Education has developed a plan to use American Rescue Plan allocations in a manner which will best meet the needs of the students who are served by Lincoln School. In formulating this plan, stakeholders including students, parents, community members, teachers, staff and service providers were consulted. To that end, the following allocations are sought:

- Development and implementation of a summer and inter-term learning model to help offset the loss of opportunities for learning during the pandemic
- Purchase of moveable desks to promote the ability of teachers to engage students in alternative learning settings while ensuring appropriate levels of social distancing.
- Hiring of a designated part-time counselor who will focus on truancy issues and removing barriers for student attendance.
- Securing license for Panorama, a social-emotional assessment instrument which will be used to develop targeted supports and programs to meet the needs of Lincoln students.
- Purchase of Delos Compact Air Purifiers to promote the health of all members of the Lincoln School community.

Lincoln is an alternative program which serves students who have engaged in serious acts of misconduct or have a history of truancy. All the elements of this plan are geared toward supporting either the return of learners to their home district or allowing them to successfully complete a secondary program at Lincoln.
